WINEMAKER NOTES

Vinous and enticing nose of blackberry, sage, rosemary, and black plum. Earthy and spice driven. Cinnamon hints alongside savory notes of dried porcini and pancetta. Supple and rounded wine with great hydration and length. Runs the gamut of fruit from red to black to blue. Stays fresh and red with rooibos tea notes. Today, this is a wine highlighting the leather and perfume side of sangiovese with a soft dusting of ultra-fine tannins and buoyant acidity. In the upcoming years, this will be a wonderful view into the ongoing and constantly changing relationship between earth and fruit that defines the great sangiovese grape.
